Chair of Selectors:

Coaching drills and tips:

Skills Improvement:

It is better to engage in structured practice than to take part in a social game. You can make and repeat an error in social games and not realise it. This error can easily become part of your bowling technique unless corrected early

Tip:

Your aiming point on the green doesn't change irrespective of the length of the jack. Take the time to have a roll up and find your aiming point before any game, social or competitive.

Can you be an umpire:

Q - When does a player have possession of the rink?

A - Possession of the rink belongs to the player/team whose bowl is being played - law 13.1

As soon as each bowl comes to rest, possession of the rink passes to opposing player/team

after any toucher is marked – law 13.2

A player must not deliver a bowl before the previous bowl comes to rest and the possession of the rink has passed to the opposing player/team – law 13.3
